SCOPE AND CONTENT

Bill Todd and Art Bratt gifted their collection of GLAMA material to the LaBudde Special Collections in August of 2011. Inclusive dates are 1978 – 2012, with the bulk of materials in the 1987 – 1991 range, focusing on the Gay and Lesbian Alliance, an organization to which Bill Todd and Art Bratt were deeply dedicated. Included are photographs, scrapbooks, correspondence, periodicals, numerous news clippings, ephemera, memorabilia, audio and video cassettes. The highlight of this collection undeniably lies within the 48 scrapbooks which document the activities; adversities; goals and triumphs of the LGBT community. Of particular interest are two scrapbooks containing material gathered during the National March on Washington, D.C., October 11, 1987. These scrapbooks along with video tapes and photographs record an historical event that culminated in a demonstration reminiscent of the civil rights marches of the 1960's. 200,000 people, gay Americans and a diverse coalition of their supporters, calling for more Federal money for AIDS research and treatment and for an end to discrimination against homosexuals. In addition to the 1987 March, there are also photographs and news clipping of the April 1993 March on Washington.

To peruse this collection is to feel the spirit of those who have devoted their time and energy to social education, changing the presence of hate and bigotry that divide our nation, and promoting the notion that civil liberties & equality are every individual's birthright. There is a plethora of material for any researcher covering a multitude of topics: LGBT issues, AIDS, Politics, Discrimination, Religion, Environmental Issues, etc. Another rich source to reference is the more than 500 periodicals, along with news clippings, covering Local, National and World events and stories. There are 198 photographs along with video tapes that bring life to the manuscripts by putting faces to people and happenings.

The Bill Todd and Art Bratt Collection is, at the very least, an insightful gaze into the bubble that sometimes is our world and transitions us to venture outward and discover and experience civility and compassion and at the uppermost, refrain from setting boundaries on human existence.

SERIES NOTES

Series I: Correspondence

Correspondence is located in box 1, folders 1 – 4, and contains personal correspondence as well as outreach from various organizations. It has been sorted by affiliation or subject matter.

Series II: Gay & Lesbian Awareness (GALA)

This series is found in box 1, folders 5 – 17, and holds organizational papers. Included are correspondence; financial records; operating procedures; contracts; and numerous documentation related to GALA Pride Events from 1989 – 1991. 1991 Calendar orders are located in box 15; The 1991 Calendar is located in box 14, folder 10, and an Expense Spreadsheet is located in box 17, folder 2. There are also Scrapbooks related to GALA that are held in Series III, sub-series A.

Series III: Scrapbooks

Series III is located in box 1, folders 18 – 26; boxes 2 – 8; box 9, folders 1 – 11, and box 14, folders 4 – 6, and is divided into two sub-series. A: GALA & B: Aids & Gay & GLAMA Articles. Subject matter includes GALA Events; News Clippings and the National March on Washington. The majority of the Scrapbooks are sorted by date in ascending order. They have been removed from their original binders for preservation purposes and placed in archival containers with no compromise to their original arrangement.

Series IV: Miscellaneous

This series is located in box 9, folders 12 – 16, and contains subject matter which does not fall into other series categories. Included are Theatre programs; Flyers; Posters; Catalogs; G.O.A.L., Inc. verses the ATA; etc.

Series V: Publications

Series V has been divided into four sub-series. A: Newsletters/Bulletins, located in box 9, folders 17 - 20; box 10 & box 11, folders 1 – 10. B: Magazines, located in box 11, folders 11 – 20 & box 12, folders 1 – 4. C: Oversized Periodicals are found in boxes 17 – 19. D: Misc. Publications are located in box 12, folders 5 – 7. Within sub-series A – C, items are sorted in alphabetical order.

Series VI: News Clippings.

News Clippings are divided into three sub-series. A: General is located in box 12, folder 8 – 19, and box 13, folders 1 – 18; B: Newsweek is located in box 13, folders 19 – 24, and C: Internet News is found in box 13, folders 25 – 31, and box 14, folders 1 – 3. Sub-series A & B are sorted by year, while sub-series C is sorted by subject matter.

Series VII: National March on Washington, D.C.

This series is located in box 14, folders 4 – 7, and includes scrapbooks; ephemera; memorabilia and video cassettes on the Historical National March on Washington, October 11, 1987.

Series VIII: Tapes – Video & Audio

Located in box 14, tapes include documentation of GALA Pride Events; Historic National March on Washington, D.C. and a phone message concerning an editorial piece in the Kansas City Star.

Series IX: Photographs

Photographs are located in box 16. An inventory of the photograph collection is accessible through an in-house database. Contact Special Collections with specific questions or for more information.

Series A: Communications
